

Registration for Classes

Once a student has been admitted to GSCC, the student may enroll in those courses for which he or she is qualified, but only during a time designated by the College as a registration period. (The Gadsden State calendar, which appears in this catalog and online, provides registration dates). A schedule of courses to be offered for each term is published online prior to the time of registration. Students with 24 or more credit hours are eligible to register during priority registration.
